Individuals who have earned an Adobe Certified Associate certification in Digital Video using Adobe Premiere Pro have demonstrated mastery of the following skills:

Domain 1.0 Setting Project Requirements

- 1.1 Identify the purpose, audience, and audience needs for editing video.
- 1.2 Summarize how digital video professionals make decisions about the type of content to include in a project, including considerations such as copyright, audience needs, permissions, and licensing.
- 1.3 Demonstrate knowledge of project management tasks and responsibilities.
- 1.4 Communicate with others (such as peers and clients) about editing plans.

Domain 2.0 Understanding Digital Video

- 2.1 Understand key terminology related to digital video.
- 2.2 Demonstrate knowledge of basic principles and best practices employed in the digital video industry.
- 2.3 Demonstrate knowledge of how to use transitions and effects to enhance video content.
- 2.4 Demonstrate knowledge of how to use audio to enhance video content.
- 2.5 Demonstrate knowledge of how to use still images and titles to enhance video content.

Domain 3.0 Understanding Adobe Premiere Pro CC

- 3.1 Identify elements of the Premiere Pro user interface, and demonstrate knowledge of their functions.
- 3.2 Define the functions of commonly used tools, including the Selection, Track Selection, Ripple Edit, Rolling Edit, Rate Stretch, Pen, Razor, Slide, Slip, Hand, and Zoom tools.
- 3.3 Navigate, organize, and customize the workspace.

Domain 4.0 Editing Digital Video Using Adobe Premiere Pro

- 4.1 Create a new project.
- 4.2 Import media and assets into a project.
- 4.3 Demonstrate knowledge of how to set up and navigate a video sequence in Premiere Pro.
- 4.4 Organize and manage video clips in a sequence.
- 4.5 Trim clips.
- 4.6 Manage sound in a video sequence.
- 4.7 Manage superimposed text and shapes in a video sequence.
- 4.8 Add and manage effects and transitions in a video sequence.

Domain 5.0 Exporting Video with Adobe Premiere Pro

- 5.1 Demonstrate knowledge of export options for video.
- 5.2 Demonstrate knowledge of how to export video from Premiere Pro.
